Against this backdrop, the correspondents from the Belt and Road Initiative Tax Journal (BRITJ) interviewed Mr. Ali Sapargaliyevich Altynbayev, Chairman of the State Revenue Committee of Ministry of Finance of Kazakhstan (SRC).
