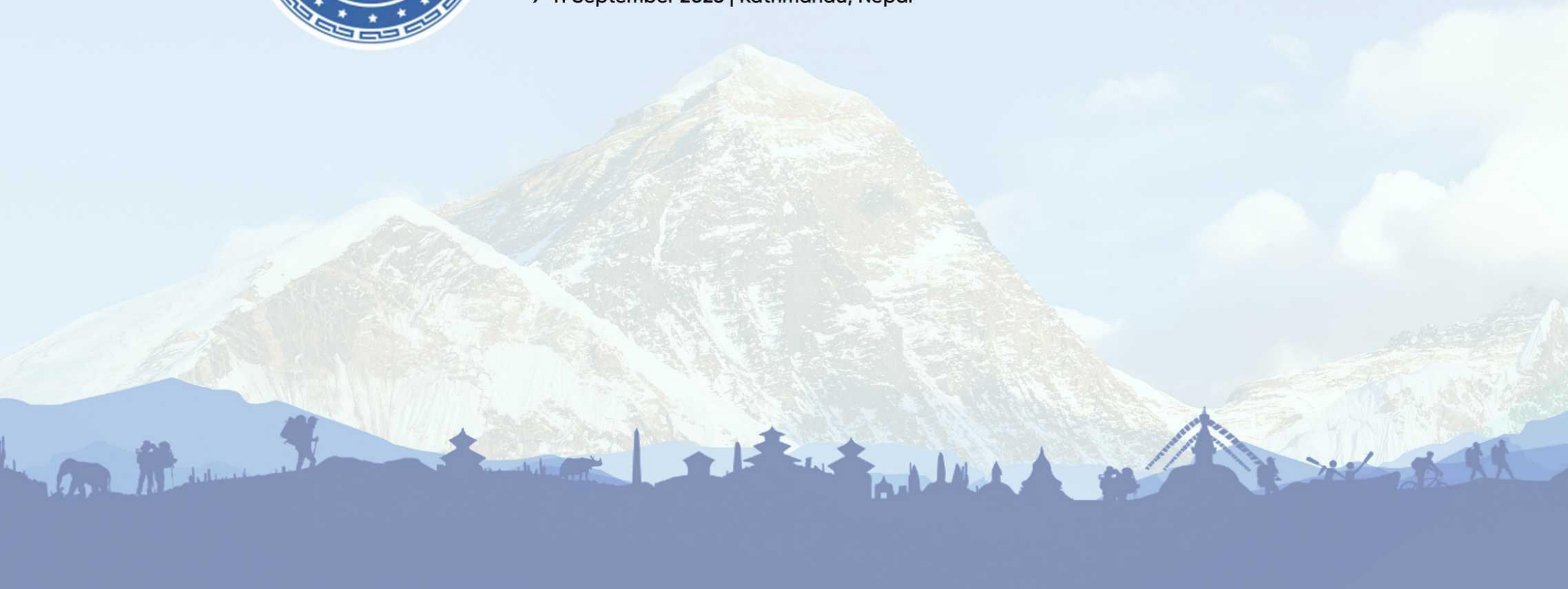

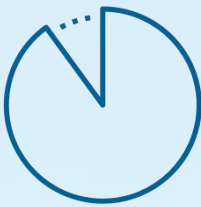

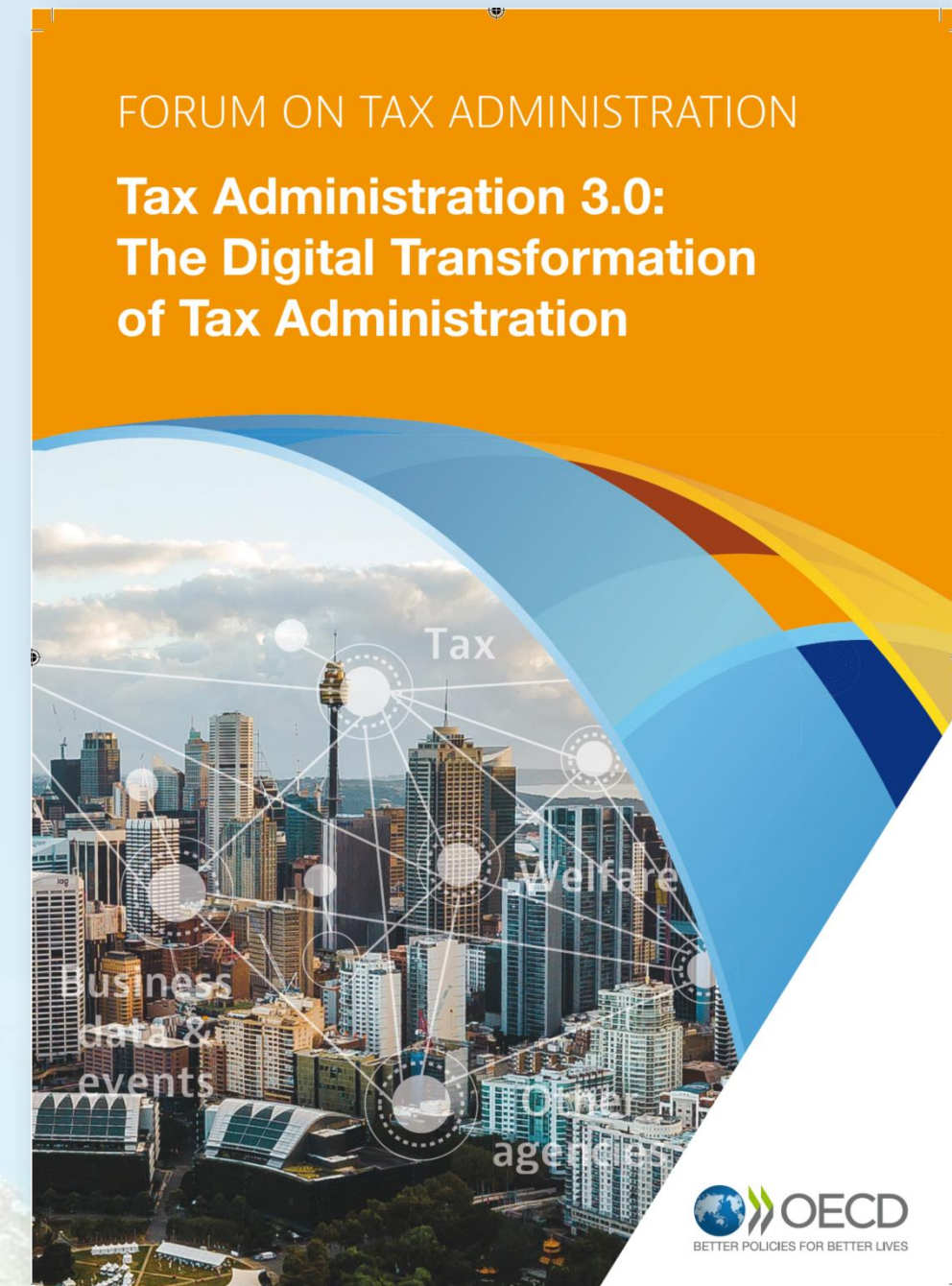
OECD Forum on Tax Administration

-  Employ 1 700 000 staff

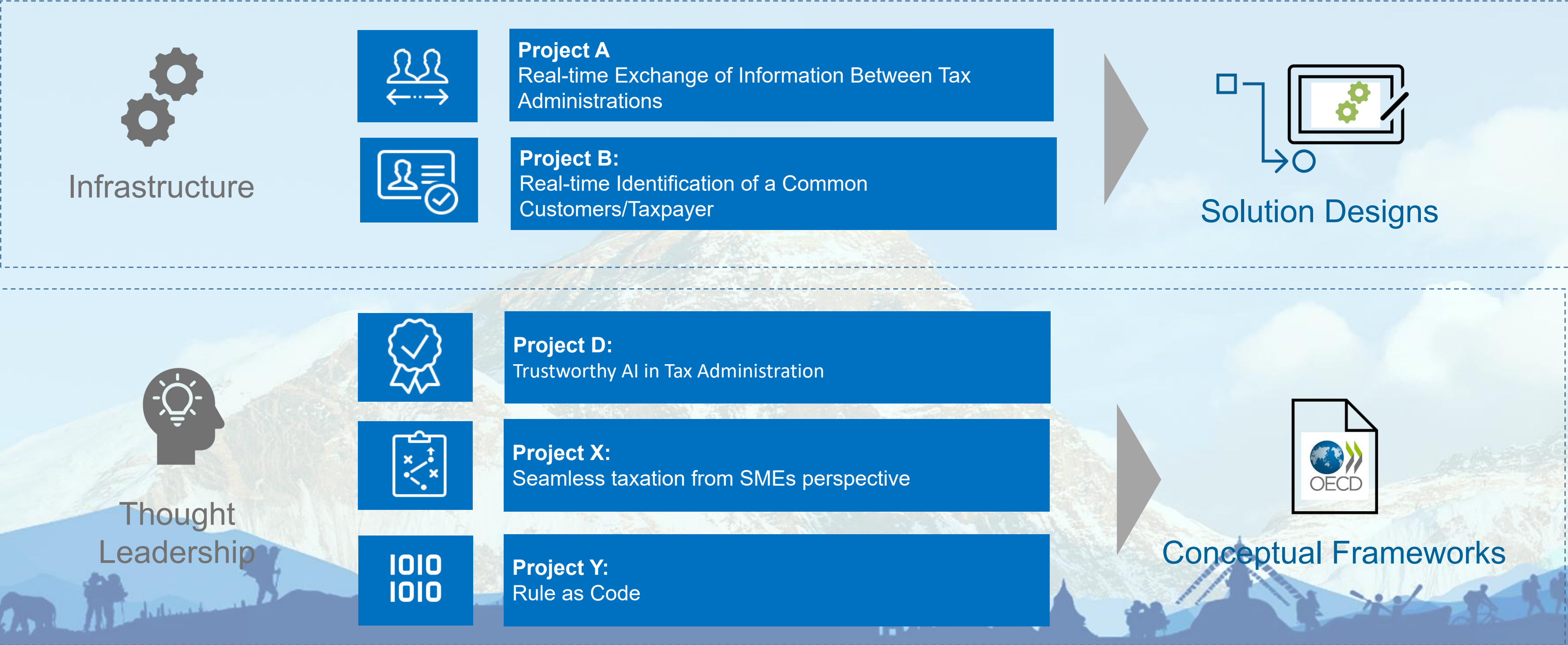

Inventory of Tax Technology Initiatives (ITTI)

The inventory contains information on technology tools and digitalisation solutions implemented by tax administrations globally:

- Tool for identifying good practices, and to understanding the direction tax administrations are heading globally,
- Assisting tax administrations in their considerations of possible domestic reforms, and
- Helps identifying where future collaboration between tax administrations might be of most value

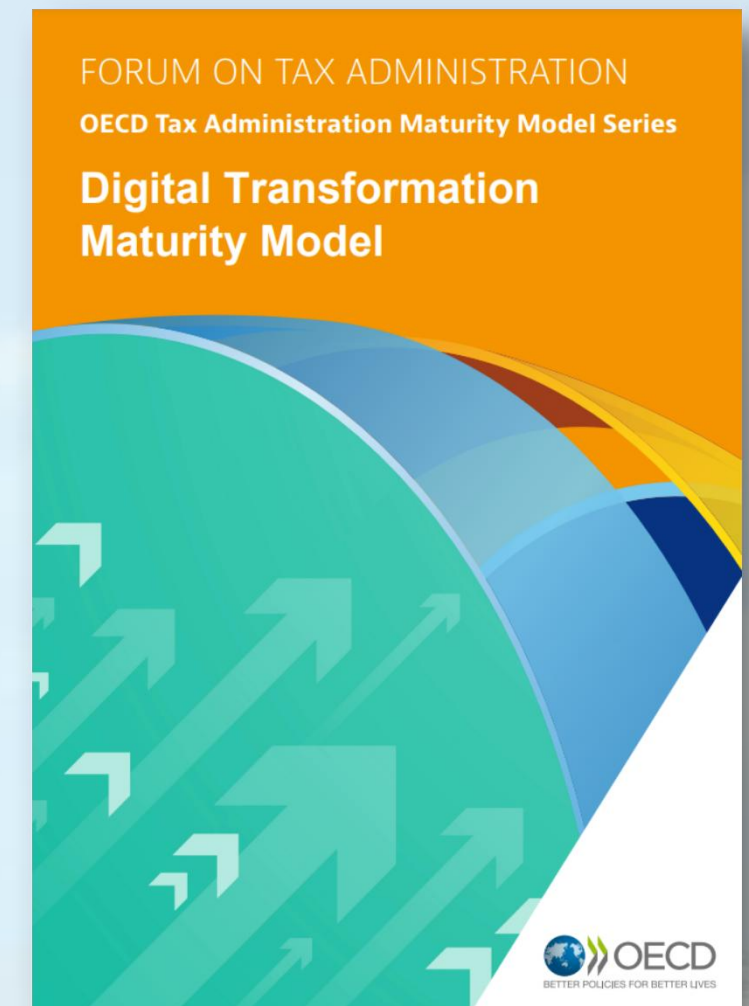
Developed by OECD together with 9 partner organisations

ITTI provides information on 104 tax administrations



Digital Transformation Maturity Model (DTMM)

- A diagnostic tool to self-assessing tax administrations current level of digital maturity
- The tool can help identifying areas for improvement and input into strategies for digitalisation and digital transformation
- Allows tax administrations to compare their level of maturity with their peers
- Around 60 tax administrations have completed the DTMM so far
